Sheri is largely self-taught and has taken courses in painting, lithography, stained glass, and encaustics. Sheri's work is sold internationally, has been publicized in both local, provincial news papers, and online; She has won awards in juried art competitions within Canada. Sheri is an annual member of the Sunbury Shores Gallery in St. Andrews, New Brunswick. And displays year round at 'Symbiosis Gallery', also located in St. Andrews, NB"


