## THE CHARLOTTE GLENCROSS SCHOLARSHIP FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE ARTS

### Juried Scholarship

The New Brunswick Foundation for the Arts offers a juried scholarship to support professional development in the arts. The scholarship will be awarded to the most promising candidate on the basis of the applications submitted. The prize will be presented during an event highlighting the vitality of the arts in New Brunswick.

#### OBJECTIVES

- To support an artist or craftsperson who seeks to build upon a new practice or establish a new direction in their work, and
- To encourage the development of New Brunswick talent in the arts.

#### PRIZE

The NBFA offers the **Charlotte Glencross Scholarship for Professional Development in the Arts** to a candidate who has demonstrated exceptional potential and talent as an artist; intends to study arts at a recognized institution or with a recognized private instructor for the purpose of pursuing a career as a professional artist or an arts professional. The Charlotte Glencross Scholarship is in the amount of \$1,000. One prize each year may be awarded.

#### ELIGIBILITY

Only New Brunswick residents are eligible. A resident is defined as a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant who has resided in New Brunswick for at least one year immediately preceding the application deadline. Students may re-apply every year. Eligible applications are evaluated by a jury of professional artists and arts administrators.

#### APPLICATIONS DEADLINE: June 30

All applicants must provide a Résumé including professional experience, exhibitions or performances and any achievements which pertain to the application. Must also be provided: a typed letter to the jury outlining the professional career plans of the applicant, photocopy of program/course description and tuition fee as provided by the institution or private instructor, résumé of the private instructor (if applicable), and sample of most recent works on CD-ROM (max 20). The NBFA reserves the right not to allocate the scholarship if the applications submitted do not meet the criteria of the program.
